# Safety First

## **Active Shooter**

A gunman or gunmen killing or attempting to kill people in a confined populated area

# Safety First

## Active Shooter Event

### Important Information

- Most Active Shooter events are over in 10 to 15 minutes
- Law Enforcements first responsibility in an Active Shooter event is to stop the suspect
- Medical teams will enter the scene once the suspect(s) is no longer a threat or is confirmed in another location
- Pre planning and training is a must!
- Know your surroundings

# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event

### What to do during

- Run
- Hide
- Defend yourself

# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event

### Run

Getting out of the area of the Active Shooter is always the best option.

- Stay Calm and Think Clearly
  - Find Cover or Concealment that will allow you to leave the area
- Cover
  - Something that will stop a bullet
- Concealment
  - Something that keeps you out of sight

# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event Run

- Get Out
  - Know where multiple exits are from your location
- Visualize your movement in advance



# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event

### Hide

- If you are unable to exit the area where the Active Shooter is your next option is to hide
  - If you need to hide choose a room that you can lock or barricade shut
- A belt or doorstop can be used to help prevent a door from being completely opened, if it can not be locked

# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event Hide

- Silence cell phones
- Remain Quiet
- Continue to formulate a plan, in the event you are located by the shooter

# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event Defend Yourself

- If you cannot exit the area of the Active Shooter or find a place to hide your last option is defend yourself

# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event Defend Yourself

- Improvised Weapon
  - Almost anything can be turned into a weapon to defend yourself
  - Broom, Keys, Fire Extinguisher...
- Striking Areas
  - Weapon
  - Sight
  - Respiration

# Safety First

## Surviving an Active Shooter Event When Law Enforcement Arrives

- They are going to be in a heightened state of readiness and awareness
- Keep your hands visible and follow instructions
- Identify yourself to law enforcement
  - Avoid running directly towards law enforcement when applicable
- If you saw the suspect provide a description
